COVID-19 UPDATE

The Government have announced all Primary aged pupils have access to LFT (Lateral Flow tests). We advise you take your child to be tested weekly. You will get the results within an hour.

These tests CAN ONLY be taken if your child has no symptoms.

If your child or anyone in the household has symptoms such as new, continuous cough OR high temperature or loss of, or change in taste or smell you MUST arrange a PCR test (this is where you need to wait up to 48 hours for the results)

Other symptoms include: fatigue and lethargy, shortness of breath, headache, sore throat, aching muscles, diarrhoea and vomiting.

Hello Everyone

The Governors are still meeting virtually to support the school in this continuing Covid era.
