MESSAGE FROM CHAIR OF GOVERNORS—HELEN MORRIS

As we reach the end of the summer term and the year 6 children leave us to continue their school experiences in other settings, we send them all our best wishes for their future steps in life.

I am sure that all our staff and pupils will be looking forward to a well-deserved break. It has been another busy year and we have a lot of successes, including a triumphant OFSTED inspection. The Governors would like to express a massive thank you for the continued dedication and hard work of all the team at Tiverton School who continue to provide the highest standard of teaching and care.

We are looking to recruit to the Governing Board. Being a School Governor is a very rewarding experience, as we hold an important role in shaping the strategic development of the school to ensure quality provision for our pupils. The term of office for a Governor is initially three years. Governors are expected to attend 6 meetings a year – approximately 1 every half term, these are currently during the school day. Most employers will allow time off for their staff to attend these meetings. Every Governor also monitors the success of a specific area, such as reading or health & safety. Training is available and those new to being a Governor are required to attend induction training in full. If you know anyone who would like more information, please speak to Alison or Aysha.

ATTENDANCE

Every day off school makes a big difference to the attendance over the year and will impact your child's learning.

We understand this can be hard at times but please contact the school if you need any help or advise.

Please remember that holidays should be avoided during term time or you could incur a fine from the Local Authority. School are unable to authorise holidays.

HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME– PENALTY NOTICES

All schools discourage holidays taken in term time, apart from where there are exceptional circumstances. If you do decide to take holiday in term time that is not authorised you may have to pay a penalty notice.

From August 2024, the Department For Education are introducing a National Framework for Penalty Notices and any leave taken after this date will be dealt with under the new framework with increased fines.

First offence - The first time a Penalty Notice is issued the amount will be: £80 per parent, per child paid within 21 days. This increases to £160 per parent, per child if paid after day 21, until day 28. Any non-payment of the Penalty Notice may result in a prosecution.

Second Offence (within 3 years) - the second time a Penalty Notice is issued the amount will be £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days. Any non-payment of the Penalty Notice may result in a prosecution.

Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years) - the third time an offence is committed a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the parent(s) may be prosecuted under section 444(1A) of the Act. Fines could be up to £2500 per parent, per child.
