PUPIL PREMIUM

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are offered a free school meal funded by the Government through a programme called Universal Infant Free School Meals

You can also apply for Free School Meals if your child is on Universal Infant Free School Meals which means the school will receive more funding towards your child's education and also enable you to be able to apply for free activities such as the HAF Programme

If your child is in Y3 to Y6 and not currently on Free School Meals, please check your eligibility as they too would be eligible for activities such as the HAF Programme
